Composition: 15% wool, 9% polyamide, 9% polyester,

1% elastane, 66% polyester filling

Yarn type: Worsted Binding: Knitted

Width: Approximately 61 inches (155 cm) Weight: Approximately 1390 g/lin.m Repeat: None, length striped

Cleaning: Vacuum clean frequently, ideally every week if fixed covers. Remove stains as soon as they occur, with clean warm water or sparkling water.

Extraction clean when necessary.

Also washable at 30°C if loose covers. Drip drying. Shrinkage app. 3%. Mount in moist condition
